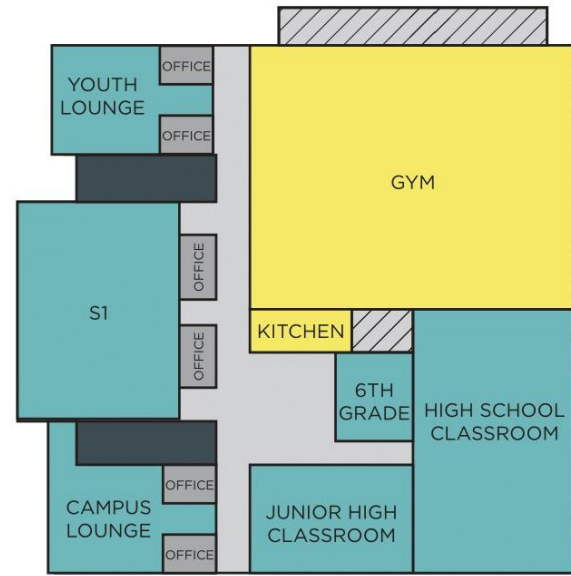

MEMORIAL ROAD CHURCH OF CHRIST FACILITIES MAP

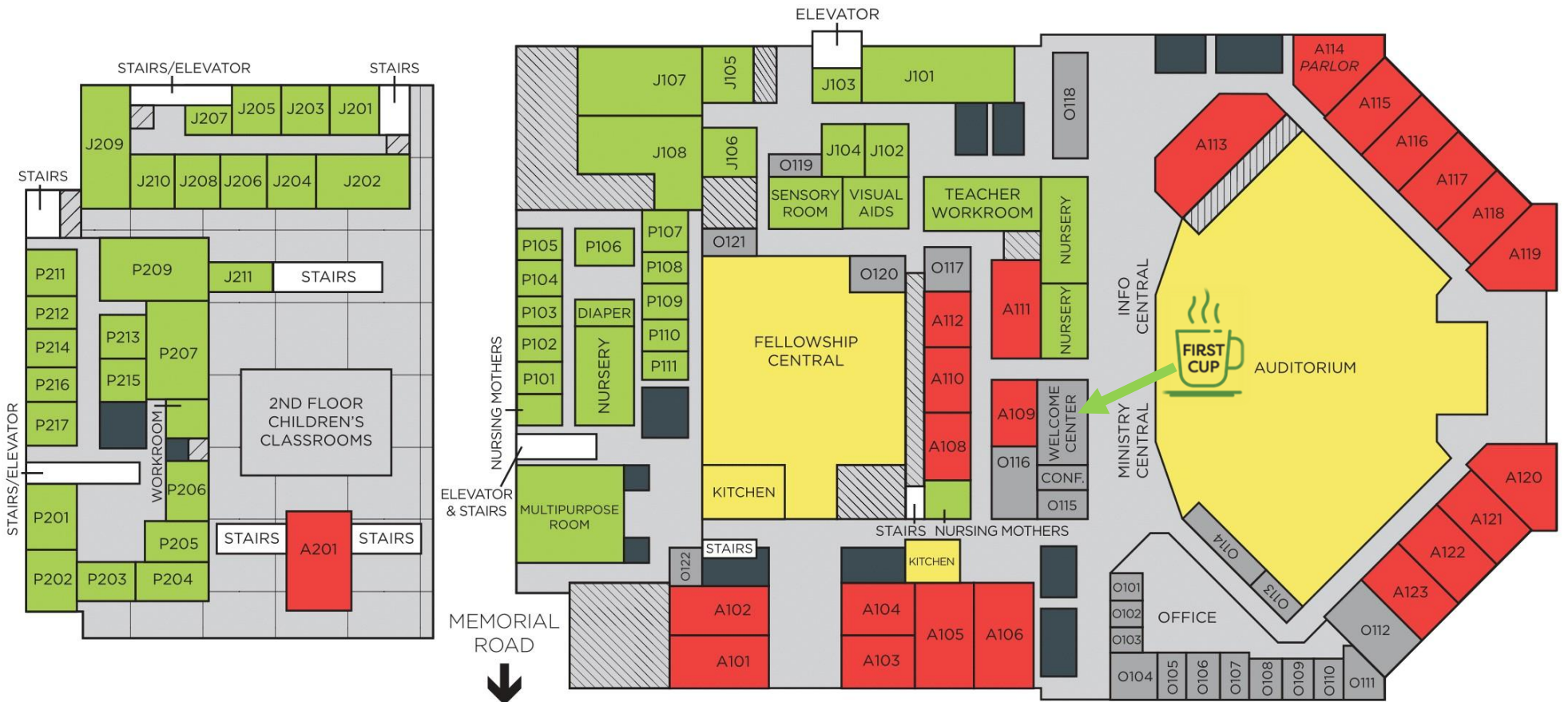
