WHAT IS THE HIM PROGRAM?

The Helpers In Missions (HIM) program, developed by Memorial Road Church of Christ (MRCC), equips recent graduates to assist established missionaries in spreading the Gospel and fulfilling the Great Commission. The HIM program places qualified young Christians with experienced missionaries in domestic and international mission points.

OBJECTIVES

1. Further the work of Christ.
2. Provide young adults training in Christian service to equip them for further works at home and abroad.
3. Encourage young adults to consider returning to the mission field.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Complete an undergraduate college degree
- Have a love for lost souls and a desire to serve in a mission site
- Be a young person of demonstrated integrity and spirituality (1 Tim. 4:12)

SERVICE

Domestic in the US, or international in a foreign country – a HIM worker will be placed with a capable and experienced missionary or evangelist who is willing to supervise. Length of service is typically 2 years; this may be shortened (or extended for a 3rd year) in extraordinary circumstances.
